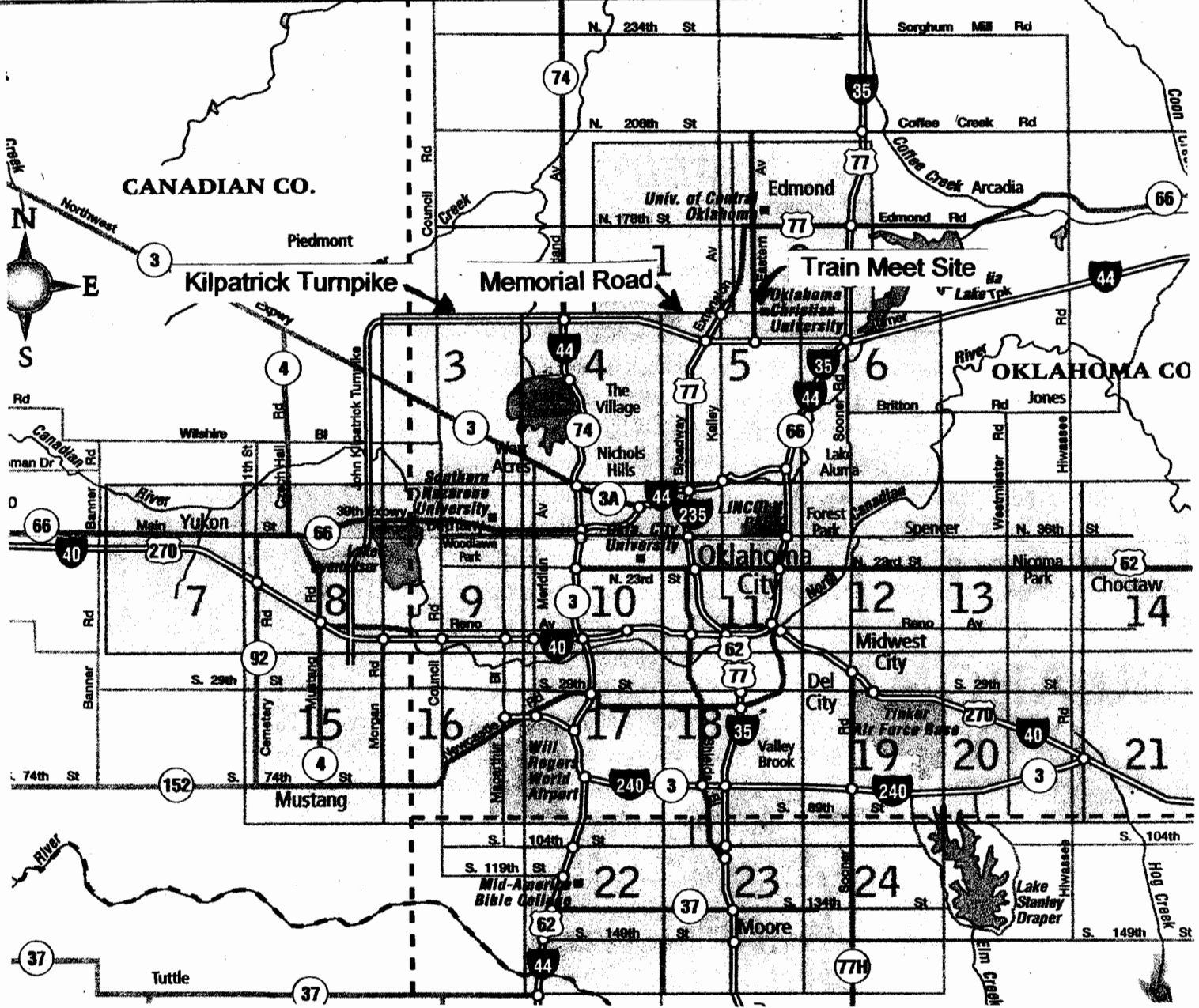

Train Related and Other Activities in the Oklahoma City Area

O SCALE LAYOUT. Our 30' by 30' club layout will be open during the train meet. It has two levels with narrow gauge on the top level and dual gauge on the bottom. Track on both levels is now operational but scenery is just getting started. Please visit, we are only a mile away from the train meet. Maps and times available at the meet.

OKLAHOMA RAILWAY MUSEUM. It is located at I-35 and Grand Blvd. on the east side of the city. THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE that tours the country is visiting our museum and will be giving rides both days of our meet. Anyone with kids or grandkids might want to check it out. Museum has a depot, locomotives, equipment and a 1.9 mile ride.

LOCO. This is a live steam group with an operating system located about 20 miles east of Oklahoma City. Sat. will be a work day and Sun. an operating day, both days open to us.

OMNIPLEX. This museum has a large operating O scale layout plus a lot of equipment in display cases. Location - NE 52nd St. and M.L. King Blvd. Open daily 9 - 5, Sat. 9 - 6, Sun. 12 - 6. Adult \$7.50, senior \$6.75.

OKLAHOMA CITY NATIONAL MEMORIAL. The Memorial to the victims of the Murrah Building Bombing is open 24 hours daily. The adjacent Museum is open 9 am - 6 pm Mon - Sat, 1 pm - 6 pm Sun.

NATIONAL COWBOY & WESTERN HERITAGE CENTER. Located on I-44 near M.L. King Blvd. Open everyday 9 am - 5 pm.

EL RENO TROLLEY. The city of El Reno (about 30 miles west of Oklahoma City) has a trolley line featuring a restored 1924 streetcar. It runs from 10am - 4pm Wed thru Sat. and 1pm - 4pm Sun. It departs from the El Reno Railroad museum which is located in the old Rock Island station which has some good exhibits. Tickets are \$3 adult, \$1.50 children/over 65 and handicapped.
